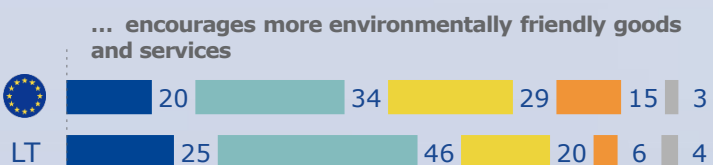
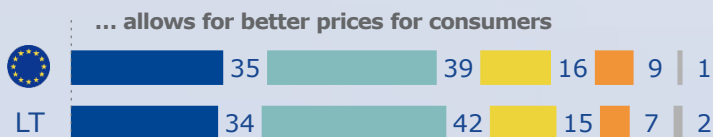
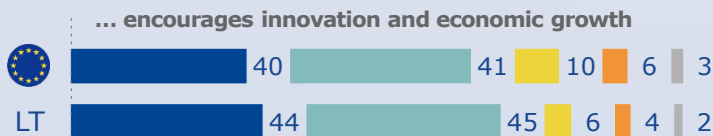
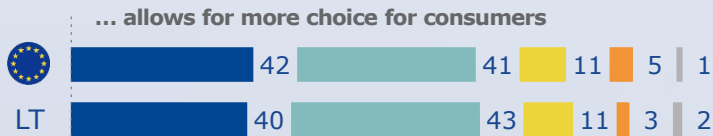

q5 For each of the following statements, please tell me whether you totally agree, tend to agree, tend to disagree or totally disagree? (%)

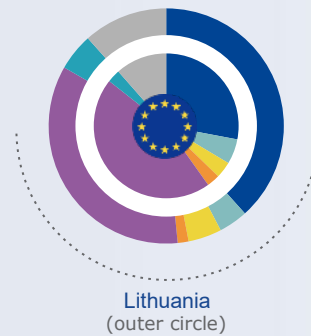

q1 If you were to identify a major problem in terms of competition, where or who would you turn to? (%)

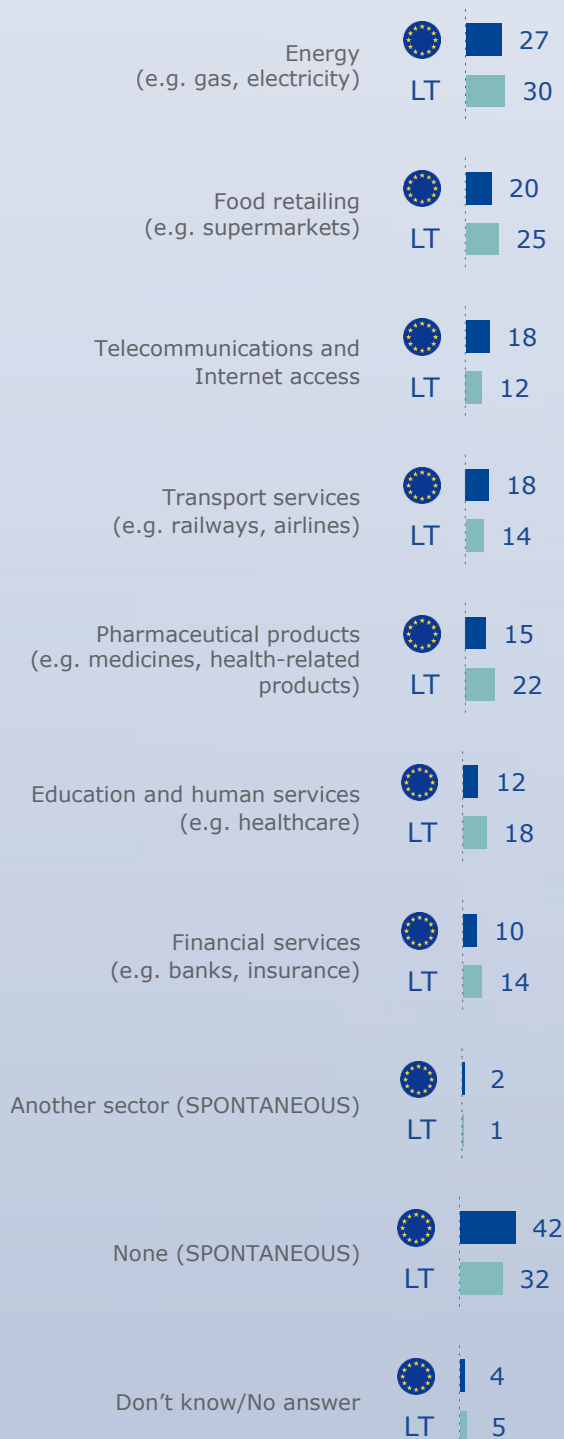
